

## Possible directions

- Green last-mile transport through strategic collaboration between municipalities and businesses in developing cargo bike plans
- Boost circularity by bringing municipalities, NGOs and citizens together to develop and maintain a digital platform to collect and redistribute functioning or repairable household objects
- Balance energy loads in cities, e.g. by training municipalities on the strategic use of smart metering systems in neighbourhoods
- Reduce waste in the building sector by creating and testing a material bank to match construction and demolition waste producers with consumers
