

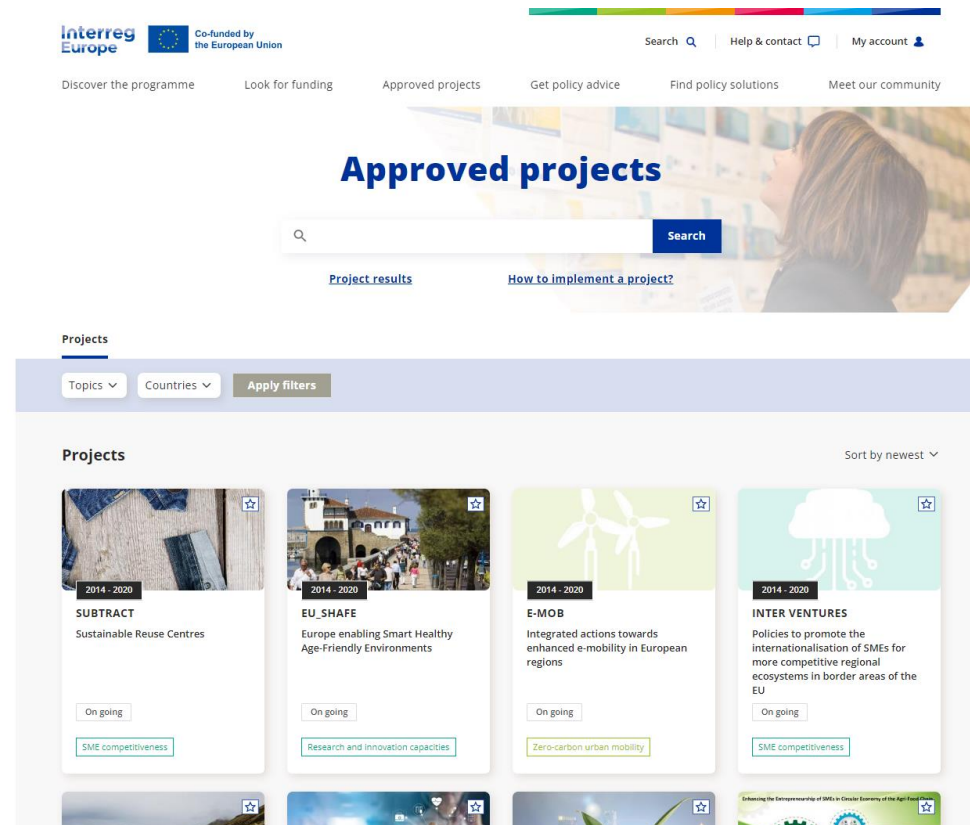
1 Issue definition

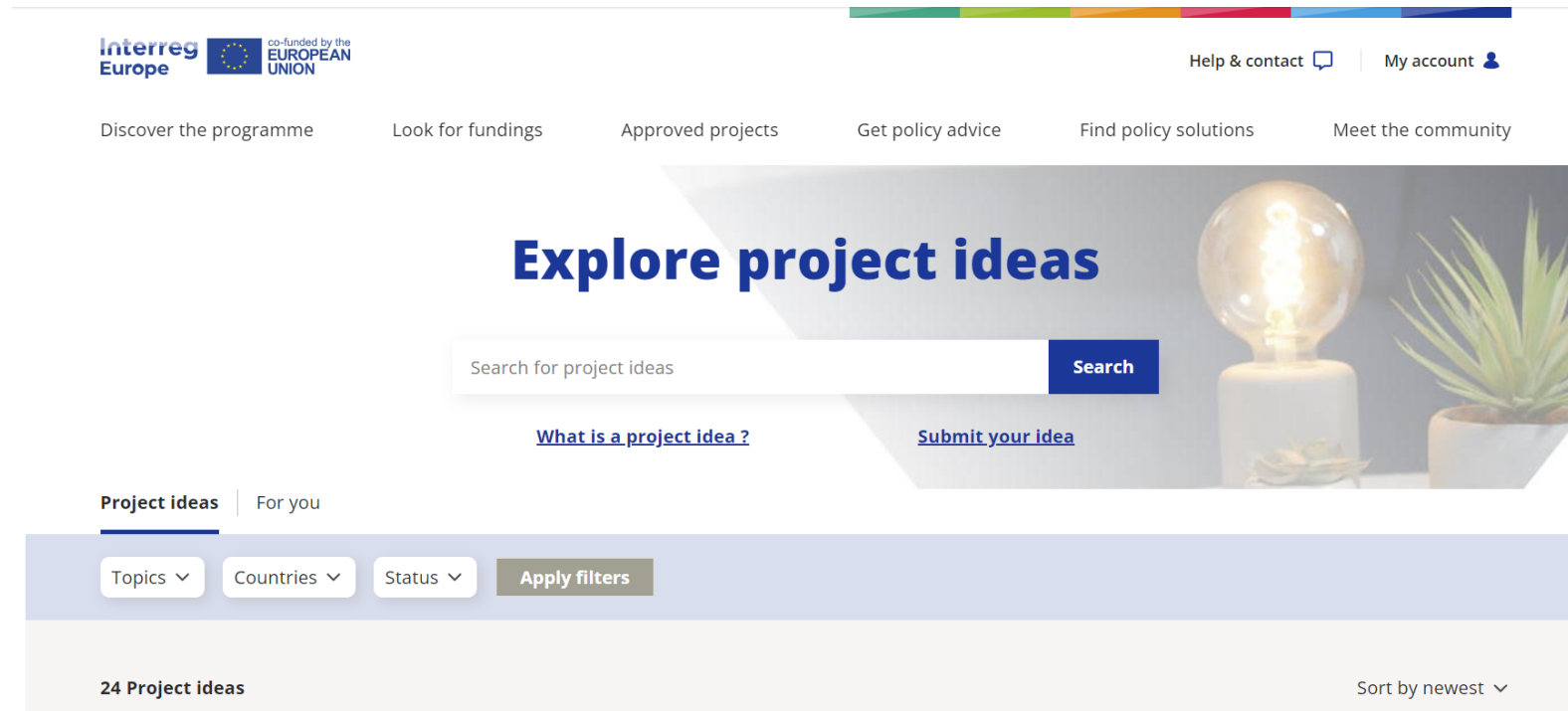

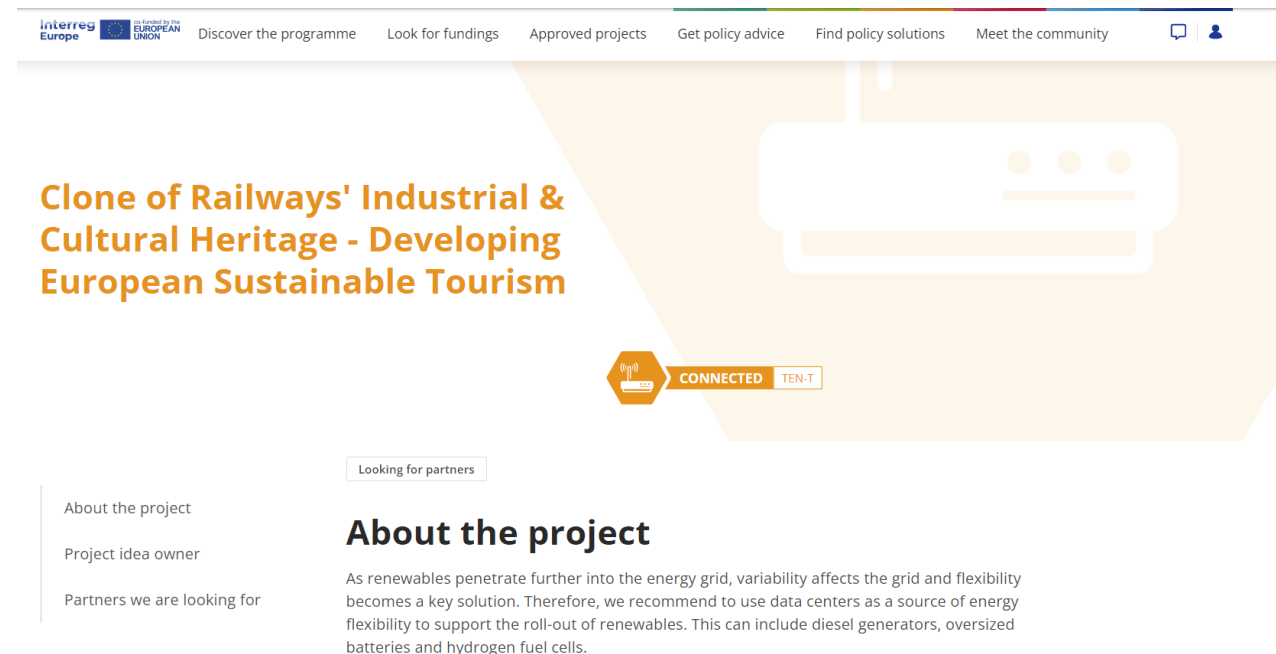

Publish your project idea on our website to tell others:

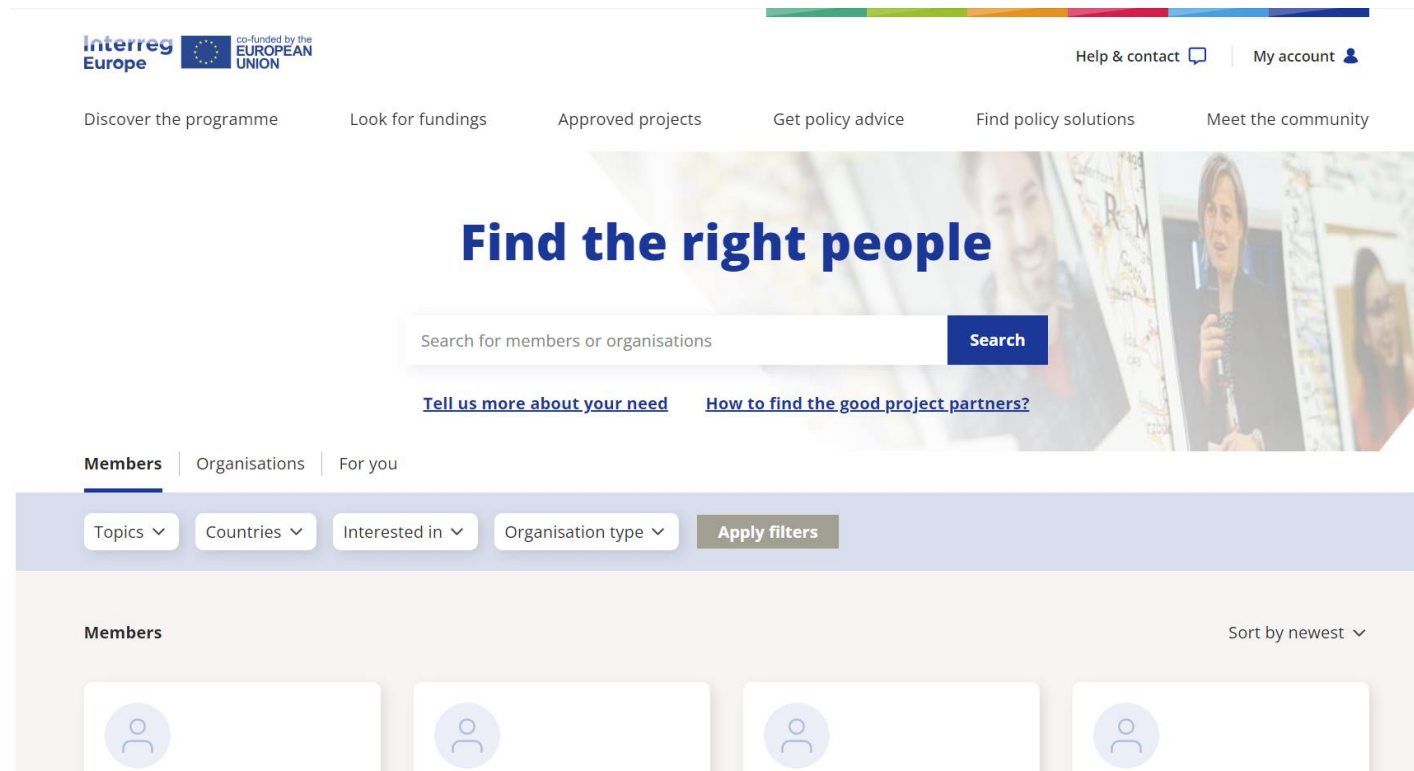
